The Board will accept public comment via email. Those wishing to make public comment should email their public comments to the Board office at nbop@govmail.state.nv.us. Written public comments must be received prior to the start of the hearing. Public comments will be included in the public record (meeting minutes) but will not necessarily be read aloud during the meeting. In compliance with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 241 (Open Meeting Law), no action may be taken on items raised by public comment that are not already on the agenda.

Items on this Agenda may be taken out of order and/or combined or consideration, and items may be pulled or removed from the agenda at any time. Public comment will be taken at the beginning and end of the hearing. The public may provide comment on any matter whether or not that matter is a specific topic on the agenda. However, prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual, public comment may not be permitted on that item (NRS 233B.126). Public comment that is willfully disruptive is prohibited, and individuals who willfully disrupt the meeting may be removed from the meeting (NRS 241.030(5)(b)). A closed session may be convened to consider the character, alleged misconduct, professional competence or physical or mental health of a person (NRS 241.030). Once all items on the agenda are completed, the meeting will adjourn.
